Mission Statement: The Junior League of Kingston NY, Inc. is part of an international organization of women committed to promoting voluntarism, developing the potential of woman, and improving communities through effective action and leadership of trained volunteers. Its purpose is exclusively educational and charitable.

Criteria:

The Anita Williams Peck Scholarship was named in 2019 to honor a longtime League member who worked tirelessly to educate and empower young people, women, and families, protect the local environment, and advance community projects of all kinds. Her generous spirit and legendary volunteerism left a lasting impact on family, friends, service organizations, and communities throughout Ulster County.

As part of its Mission Statement, the Junior League of Kingston works to develop women's potential. In honor of Anita Peck and in keeping with that goal, this scholarship is awarded to one (1) female living in Ulster County (or the JLK's surrounding service area) who is beginning or returning to school as a full-time, "non-traditional" student (aged 25 years or older). Applications are open to all community members, JLK members and nonmembers alike. The successful applicant is enrolled in an associate, bachelor's, or master's degree program and demonstrates a strong commitment to advancing her education and developing her potential.

Application Requirements:

1. A completed application and supporting documentation received by the application deadline
2. Documentation of current enrollment, letter of acceptance, or most recent transcripts from an accredited associate, bachelor's, or master's degree program
3. A personal letter of recommendation from a community member she knows well through school or volunteer work. Please have the letter writer include his/her name, address, and phone number in the reference.
4. An essay in which the applicant elaborates on the following theme:
 - "This scholarship will help me reach my highest potential and goal to ..."
5. The Committee reserves the option to request an interview
