Award Amount: \$1,000 per scholarship (2 available)

Note: Incomplete applications will not be considered

Mission Statement: The Junior League of Kingston NY, Inc. is part of an international organization of women committed to promoting voluntarism, developing the potential of woman, and improving communities through effective action and leadership of trained volunteers. Its purpose is exclusively educational and charitable.

Criteria:

To qualify, the applicant must be a female, college-bound high school senior residing in Ulster County who demonstrates a strong commitment to volunteering and plans to further her education. The recipient must show contributions to her community through volunteer service. A special committee appointed by the Junior League of Kingston, NY, Inc. will select the recipient.

Application Requirements:

1. A completed application and supporting documentation received by the application deadline
2. Documentation of community service
3. Three letters of recommendation, one from **each** of the following categories: community service reference, personal reference, and advisor/teacher reference. Name, address and contact number of references are required.
4. A one-page essay describing volunteer experiences and how these activities benefited the applicant and her community
5. An up-to-date transcript, which may be unofficial
6. The Committee reserves the option to request an interview
