**Award Amount: \$1,500 per scholarship (2 available)**

**Note: Incomplete applications will not be considered.**

### **Mission Statement:**

The Junior League of Kingston, NY, Inc. is part of an international organization of women committed to advancing women's leadership for meaningful community impact through volunteer action, collaboration, and training.

### **Criteria:**

The applicant must be a female, college-bound high school senior residing in Ulster County who demonstrates a strong commitment to volunteering. The recipient must show contributions to her community through volunteer service.

### **Application Requirements:**

1. A completed application and supporting documentation received by the application deadline.
2. Documentation of community service.
3. Three (3) letters of recommendation that includes the name, address, and contact number for each reference. The applicant must include a letter from **each** of the following categories:
  - I. Community Service Reference
  - II. Personal Reference
  - III. Advisor/Teacher Reference
4. A one (1) page essay describing volunteer experiences and how these activities benefited the applicant and her community.
5. An up-to-date transcript, which may be unofficial.

The Junior League of Kingston's Scholarship Committee reserves the right to request an interview with the applicant as part of the selection process.
